The last thing I want to touch on is the Monthly Siren Test that we do every 2nd Saturday of the month. I want to thank all those volunteers that have helped on this project this past summer. I have talked with Bob Jackson – Director of Grant County EMA and he has told me that we will continue to do the Siren Test thru the winter months. The reasoning for doing it during the winter months is because severe weather can happen at anytime during the year. We have been tasked with reporting all 31 Sirens in the County. Since we do not have 31 volunteers we will alternate Sirens. Below is the list of Sirens in Grant County by towns and the number of Sirens in each town.

Fairmount: 3 Sirens Gas City: 5 Sirens Swayzee: 1 Siren Van Buren: 1 Siren

Fowlerton:1 SirenMarion:9 SirensSweetser:4 Sirens

Jonesboro: 2 Sirens Matthews: 3 Sirens Upland: 2 Sirens

Some of the Sirens are rotating and some of the Sirens are non-rotating. The plan would be to get hams to cover these Sirens on a rotating basis (example: do Swayzee one month then do Sweetser the next month). I have been to all the sites and we should be able to cover a couple of Sirens in the towns that have multiple sirens by placing yourself between 2 of the sirens. I need to mention one last thing. 

This will help the D-Star and the club's 2 meter Repeater computers stay online during power outages.




Again, Thank you Bryan for this piece of equipment which will help keep Grant County Amateurs able to communicate when commercial power goes out.
