## 630 AND 2200 METER BANDS AVAILABLE FOR HAM USE

The FCC announced that the Office of Management and Budget has approved, for 3 years, the information-collection requirement of the Commission's March 29 Report and Order (R&O) that spelled out Amateur Radio service rules for the two new bands – 630 meters And 2200 meters. The R&O in PDF format can be found at,

Before using either band, stations must notify the Utilities Technology Council (UTC), formerly the Utilities Telecom Council, that they plan to do so, and if UTC does not respond within 30 days, they may commence operation. The website to notify the UTC is https://utc.org/plc-database-amateur-notification-process/



## ARRL Indiana Section ARES Simulated Emergency Test (SET)

The Indiana Section ARES Simulated Emergency Test (SET) was done on September 30<sup>th</sup>. This test was to test the Amateur Radio Community in case of an emergency/disaster.


The situation was a line of powerful thunderstorms moved through the area. Strong winds, flooding rains, damaging hail and lighting has paralyzed the county. Most of the infrastructure has been effective due to the storms.

What was working as far as Amateur Radio

- VHF/UHF Simplex
- Limited Repeaters (Repeaters with back-up power)
- Limited Internet
- HF antennas with NVIS type antenna systems

The Grant County EOC was put into operation for the exercise.

Kevin Hicks – KC9MWQ and Jeff Marsee – KD9CQQ manned the EOC and ran the net from there. Chris Paul – KC9QZE was dispatched to the Van Buren area to make contact with the Northern Counties bordering Grant County. Nick Nickerson – K9NQW was dispatched to Pt. Isabel to make contact with the Southern and Western Counties bordering Grant County. Chris and Nick were to contact the surrounding counties via Simplex VHF/UHF frequencies. Chris was unable to make any contacts. Nick made contact with Howard, Delaware and Johnson counties. Kevin had 12 check-ins for the net. Kevin was also able to contact Huntington and Miami counties via repeaters from the EOC. HF communications was not successful. Chris and Nick were able to talk with each other via simplex frequencies.
