At our last club meeting several things were discussed. I will be covering these topics in this edition of the newsletter.

The first thing that needs to be discussed is we need members to volunteer for the following Committes.

1, The Amateur of the Year Committee will consider the following criteria: The Amateur of the Year exemplifies the "Amateur's Code." In selecting the award recipient, emphasis is placed on service to others rather than self, diversity of Amateur Radio interest and activities, evidence of continuing self-challenge and outstanding contributions to Amateur Radio.

2. The Life Time Membership Award Committee will consider the following criteria. All nominations must demonstrate attainment of minimum service requirements and other details of exemplary service

3. The Committee for the Election of 2024 Officers

This committee will contact members to see if they are willing to serve the club as President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Trustee. This list is to be compiled before the voting of new officers which takes place at the Christmas Party.

There must be at least 3 members of the club on each committee and members can serve on just one committee or all three. Here is an oppurtunity to get involved in the Club. The second item that was discussed at the last meeting was establishing a seperate repeater fund. This fund would be a seperate account with the funds being used strictly for maintaining the repeaters that the club uses. It was voted on by the members that a \$5.00 additional fee would be added to the membership dues starting in January 2024. This fee change was added into the club's Constitution and By-Laws. This fund would be used for such things as replacing the repeaters, new antennas, and new feedline and anything else that the club's Trustee would need to keep the repeaters up and running. We are also asking that members kick in an extra \$10.00 or more this year to get this fund started. As many of you know the main repeater 146.790 finally went down recently after almost 20 years of service and does need to be replaced. With your extra donation of \$10.00, we can get this fund started and thus we would not have to use any money from the general funds that the club has. 
